

Tips for a good Presentation

- **Visuals**: Presentation visuals should not be overly detailed or complex. One concept per visual is a reasonable target.
- **Audience**: The audience will be technical, but may be unfamiliar with your particular subject; thus, a succinct introduction to the work is appropriate and will enhance audience understanding of the presentation.
- **Intellectual Property**: Remember to avoid any content that may be restricted by intellectual property considerations, such as proprietary work conducted at other companies.
- **Summary of Work**: Consider giving a brief summary of the work early on in the presentation that quickly states the nature of the problem and major conclusions.
- **Significance of Work**: Explain the significance of the work, and clearly state your particular contributions to the field.
