## **Tips for a good Presentation**

- <u>Visuals</u>: Presentation visuals should not be overly detailed or complex. One concept per visual is a reasonable target.
- <u>Audience</u>: The audience will be technical, but may be unfamiliar with your particular subject; thus, a succinct introduction to the work is appropriate and will enhance audience understanding of the presentation.
- <u>Intellectual Property</u>: Remember to avoid any content that may be restricted by intellectual property considerations, such as proprietary work conducted at other companies.
- <u>Summary of Work</u>: Consider giving a brief summary of the work early on in the presentation that quickly states the nature of the problem and major conclusions.
- <u>Significance of Work</u>: Explain the significance of the work, and clearly state your particular contributions to the field.
