SUMMER STAFF SPOTLIGHT: RACHEL BREUNIG

In honor of Women's History Month in March , GeoFORCE wanted to highlight women in geoscience who have also played a role in teaching GeoFORCE students. Rachel served as an Educational Coach In Training (now called Research Counselor) for the 12th Grade academies in 2020 and 2021, and an Educational Coach for the Southwest 10th grade academy in 2022 for the GeoFORCE program. We are thrilled to have her join us again this summer as an Instructor for the Houston 10th grade academy.

Rachel became fascinated by geosciences through experiences she had at a young age, "I'm from Houston, and growing up, I witnessed firsthand the extremes of water shortage and water excess through droughts and floods in the city. Learning that I could apply lots of fundamental science like math, chemistry, biology, and physics to real world humanitarian issues like drastic changes in ecosystem water supply was a huge draw to me."

Rachel Breunig is currently a PhD candidate at the University of Wisconsin-Madison studying Geosciences with specializations in geomorphology & hydrogeology. She also attained a PhD minor in Civil and Environmental Engineering. She is very thankful for great friends, mentors, and colleagues, who have all shaped her experience as a woman in geoscience.

Two women who particularly impacted Rachel are her high school environmental science teacher, Ms. Carolyn Klein (Westside HS), and her undergraduate research advisor, Dr. Daniella Rempe (hydrologist and geomorphologist at UT Austin)! "These women showed me what it is to ask the hard questions, be communicators and advocates of good science, and how to innovate with the tools you have-- all things that I strive to do."

Her advice to becoming a role model for future geoscientists is to just try, even if you aren't sure what the outcome may be. "I'm a big believer in giving yourself opportunities! You may not know 100% whether you can accomplish a task when start out (or whether you even want to), but making an attempt, submitting an application, and applying what you do know seem to be the best ways to grow. Not only is there no harm in trying, but you might just find yourself doing things that you didn't think you could do."

Rachel believes strongly in the power of interactive learning and GeoFORCE's mission to broaden involvement in geoscience by engaging high school students. "The opportunities that GeoFORCE provides to its students in high school and beyond are truly unparalleled. It's pretty spectacular to play a small part in that."

GeoFORCE Texas is an outreach program through The University of Texas at Austin's Jackson School of Geosciences that introduces high school students from underserved communities to STEM and geoscience careers through summer field experiences, corporate mentoring, and college guidance. In 2015, our program was honored with the Presidential Award for Excellence in Science, Mathematics, and Engineering Mentoring—the highest such honor from the United States government.
