| 5 | Nearby Oil Beds #1 |  <p>Oil Tycoon! Rules</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Each player will choose a game piece. The property cards should be placed at the corresponding property on the board with the information about the property hidden. DO NOT LOOK AT THE DESCRIPTION UNTIL ALL THE PLAYERS HAVE COMPLETED THEIR PURCHASES! Each person receives four property tokens at the beginning to use to purchase properties you believe may have oil underground. Place player pieces on START. Roll the die to see who begins. The highest number goes first, and then the play goes to the person on the left (clockwise) in order. You may choose in which direction that you would like to go. When it's your turn, roll the die to see how many places you get to move. You may choose which direction to move your piece with each roll. If you land on a property that has already been purchased, you may roll again until you have landed on an unpurchased piece of land. If you land on an unpurchased property, you can choose to purchase it or wait until your next turn to purchase a more desirable property. Once you have purchased a property, pick up the card from the board and place it in your own inventory. Be sure not to look at the cards until the end of the game. Replace the card that was on the board with one of your property tokens to indicate that the property has already been purchased. Once you have purchased all of your properties, remove your playing piece from the game board and wait until the other players have finished. When each player has used all of their tokens, individual players may agree on any trades among properties. You may make only one trade if another player is willing to trade. Once every player has used all four tokens for properties, players will individually read the back of their cards to see if you struck oil. Any "loss," "expense" or amount you "paid" needs to be added up. Any "profit" or "sold/sale" that generates income needs to be added up separately. Once you have these totals, subtract your "loss" total from your "profit" total to get your NET PROFIT (this is how much money you made after all of your expenses.)
