- <sup>7</sup> Requires 12 hours of one course from one discipline chosen from anthropology, astronomy, biology, business, computer sciences, chemistry, education, engineering, geography, mathematics, or physics. 6 hours must be Upper Division courses.
- <sup>8</sup> 3 hours in anthropology, economics, geography, linguistics, psychology, or sociology. These hours are in addition to the University Core Social Science requirement; must be selected from a different discipline than the course chosen for the University Core Social Science.
