Internships are a valuable way to gain work experience and training directly applicable to areas of future employment and to help students decide what they may want to do after graduation. To be formally recognized as an Internship Experience for the Jackson Scholars program, the student must be enrolled in GEO 679J, 679G or 371C (conference course). At the conclusion of the internship the student must prepare a report of accomplishments and advances made during the internship, and secure a letter of evaluation from the internship supervisor for inclusion in the JS portfolio. To register for an internship the student must be in good standing and have a minimum cumulative UT and DGS GPA of 3.0.
