At the conclusion of the internship the student must prepare a report of accomplishments and advances made during the internship, and secure a letter of evaluation from the internship supervisor for inclusion in the JS portfolio. To register for an internship the student must be in good standing and have a minimum cumulative UT and DGS GPA of 3.0.
