## Jackson Scholars Plan for Scholarship Recognition Research Experience

The research element involves organized laboratory, literature, field or computational research, supervised by a faculty member or research scientist in the JSG, which results in a written project report or publication. The research project is to carried out over a minimum of 2 semesters and involves a well-defined research question, a brief proposal and a final written project report. The student must register for GEO 379K or GEO371C for at least one semester. The project report format is flexible but must be agreed upon by the student and supervisor. Proposals for unusual projects can be pre-approved by the Undergraduate Committee or Associate Dean. Research projects completed for the Department of Geological Sciences Undergraduate Honors Research Program that lead to successful completion of a thesis will automatically count as the research component of the Jackson Scholars program.
