To participate in a semester abroad program, a student must be in good standing and have a minimum UT and GEO cumulative GPA of 3.0. Courses taken at the host University must be for credit with a grade of C or better, and the course credit must be recognized by direct course equivalency or a 319S or 329S. The student must include in the JS portfolio documentation of successful course completion from UT and from the host University.
