

Jackson Scholars Plan for Scholarship Recognition Study Abroad Experience

Studying abroad can be a challenging yet rewarding experience that can broaden horizons and perspectives. To be included in the Jackson Scholar portfolio a student must participate in one of UT's recognized study abroad programs for a full semester and enrolled in the host University. 'Maymester' and Faculty-led summer programs do not count toward Jackson Scholar recognition. To participate in a semester abroad program, a student must be in good standing and have a minimum UT and GEO cumulative GPA of 3.0. Courses taken at the host University must be for credit with a grade of C or better, and the course credit must be recognized by direct course equivalency or a 319S or 329S. The student must include in the JS portfolio documentation of successful course completion from UT and from the host University.
