Community and Professional Service

A fundamental part of being an effective geoscientist is participation in the broader aspects of the profession and society in general through volunteering and service learning. Community and professional service could take the form of volunteer community service such as volunteer EMS, community hotline, or volunteering in schools and hospitals. A variety of volunteer opportunities are available through UT Volunteer and Service Learning Center, www.UTvolunteer.org. This is intended to be a major investment on the part of the student that leads toward a long-term commitment to service. Active membership in a volunteer organization for at least one year is required for Jackson Scholars. Supporting material for the JS portfolio should include a support letter from the organization's leadership and a log of service hours. Organizations must be approved prior to beginning service.
