Petition for course deficiency substitutions

All students admitted to the Graduate program are expected to have completed a minimum of two college-level courses in calculus, and four additional college-level courses in at least two other of the following subjects: *physics, chemistry, and biology*. At the discretion of the mentor/adviser, a student may petition the following substitutions. A graduate geophysics class may be substituted for one physics course, a graduate geochemistry class may be substituted for one chemistry course, and a statistics class (undergraduate or graduate) may be substituted for one calculus course.
